➤ What is this product?

Type: Vinci Compass Mexico Equity Fund (the "Fund") is a sub-fund of Vinci Compass SICAV (the "Company").

Term: There is no fixed term and the Fund may be terminated at any time in line with the constitutional documents of the SICAV.

Objectives: The Fund's investment objective is capital appreciation through active management that involves investing in Mexican companies with good growth prospects, with the potential to positively surprise investors, with robust corporate governance, and trading at attractive valuations.

Intended retail investor: This Fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 3-5 years.

Depositary: The Fund's assets are held through its Depositary, which is BNP Paribas, Luxembourg Branch.

Distribution type: The product is accumulating.

➤ What happens if Carne Global Fund Managers (Luxembourg) S.A. is unable to pay out?

➤ What are the costs?

Costs over time
